Domaine Sigalas

He is the pioneering winemaker who applied mathematics and other innovative ideas to oenology and viticulture to elevate Santorini's wines to international stardom. The 1991 Santorini is his maiden vintage, the first wine to be labelled Protected Designation of Origin, marking the start of operations at Domaine Sigalas.

Hatzidakis Winery

Hatzidakis Winery was founded in 1997 by Haridimos Hatzidakis and Konstantina Chryssou. It all started when Konstantina showed him a neglected vineyard of her family at an altitude of 330 meters in the village of Pyrgos Kallistis. In the vineyard there was a cave which with a lot of work and passion but very little money was made into a small Winery, or as Haridimos used to say a little Canava. (Canava is the name the Santorinians use for small family wineries). The vineyard where Canava was located had not been cultivated since 1956 something which was a great opportunity for an organic cultivation. It was the first vineyard in Santorini that was cultivated organically and was certified by DIO.
